## **WEDNESDAY SEPTEMBER 30<sup>TH</sup>:**

Over the past few days, the FAE (Federations Autonomes des Enseignants) have intentions to raise their pressure tactics and have officially called a legal strike day for September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2015. Due to this, it will disrupt our English side also, so the School Boards have decided to suspend all classes for both ETSB & VDC for Sutton School seeing as we share a building and are not permitted to cross a picket line. Daycare services are also cancelled for that day. Please mark on your calendar that there will be no school on Wednesday September 30<sup>th</sup>, for ALL Sutton School students.

### **SCHOOL T-SHIRTS:**

### **ANOTHER REMINDER\*\*\*PARKING LOT, DROP-OFF POINT & PEDESTRIAN CIRCULATION (A.M. & P.M.):**

Please enter very carefully into the parking area and keep a close watch for busses arriving and departing from that area. Follow the flow of the circle and drop off your children at the proper drop-off point and continue around the circle. DO NOT PARK AND GET OUT OF YOUR CAR WHILE IN THE DROP-OFF CIRCLE!

\*Please do not drop your children off at the front door unless you are arriving late. It is too dangerous in that small crowded area and too many cars back up while children are getting out of cars and running towards the door.

If every parent follows the proper procedure, then our students will be kept safe. We have already had too many close calls due to lack of following the procedures, therefore causing people to backup in the area where children are walking. You must also pay special attention to the pedestrians walking. There are many children who walk to and from school and they often must cross the entrance or parking areas to get to the sidewalk or on to the school property. Please help keep our children safe! Just imagine if it was your child!!

\*\* A little reminder also to NOT park in the Library parking at all in the morning. This is reserved for library volunteers, clients and employees until noon.
