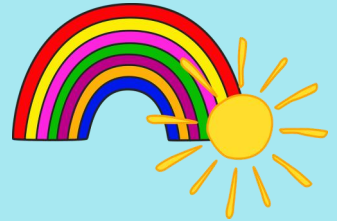
Registration period for the daycare service :

Please note that the registration period for the Sutton School daycare service will be **from May 6 to June 3.**

You will receive a form from Mosaïk to register your child(ren).

Registering does not oblige you to do anything, it allows you to have a place in case of last minute needs.

Due to the shortage of educators and/or for organizational and security reasons, the daycare service may have to temporarily refuse a new registration or a last minute addition in order to respect the ratio of twenty children to one educator as stipulated in the Regulation.

Families who have registered their children before June 6th, 2022 will have priority access to the daycare service if we are forced to limit spaces.

From May 9 to 13, 2022, it's School Child Care Week. School daycare staff have always been in great demand and even more so since the beginning of the pandemic, having responded every day to welcome children during all successive waves of confinement. School care staff are an essential link and deserve full recognition of their contribution. Take a moment to let them know your appreciation.

Don't forget that with the warmer weather coming, it is important to make sure your child(ren) are receiving proper nutrition in their lunches and plenty of water! We do not promote candy/sugar snacks in lunches.
